

## 21st Century COLA Program Policies and Procedures for Afterschool and Summer Camp Programs

- 1. Be prepared with homework assignments and materials
- Keep up with my student planner to remain on schedule with assignments and events
- 3. Be kind; respect others and yourself; no bullying
- 4. No foul language, profanity, or cursing
- 5. No cell phones or other electronic devices during the planned activities. Keep cell phones in your bags while in the program
- No hats or hoodies indoors
- 7. Respect each other's personal space
- Respect other people's property: do not take, break, disconnect, vandalize, or destroy any property
- No disruptive behavior, including throwing things, fighting or violence of any kind.Keep hands to yourself
- 10. No accessing any inappropriate or violent items on games, computers, or other electronic devices
- 11. No toys, unless it's part of a school-based, afterschool or summer camp project
- 12. No food or drinks in the classrooms unless it is approved
- 13. No running, horseplay, or loud noises in the hallways
- 14. Keep all personal items in your bag and do not exchange items with other students
- 15. Clean up behind yourself (i.e., put trash in the trash cans, push chairs under the table)
- 16. Report any concerns to an activity coordinator, teacher, volunteer, or Project Director
- 17. School rules at the 21st Century COLA Program will follow the guidelines of Northside Middle and East Point Academy.
- 18. Consequences can be amended at the Project Director's discretion
